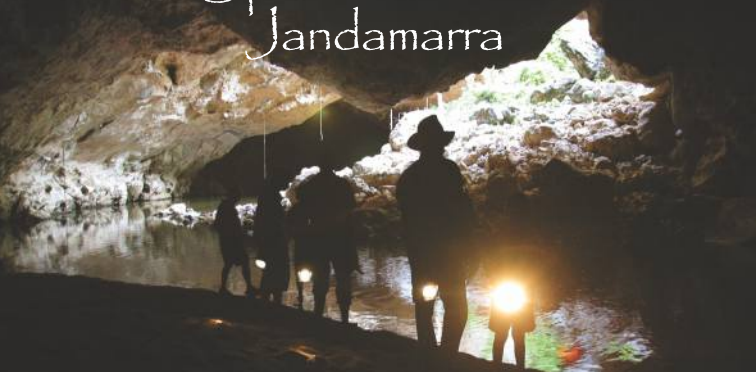


Tunnel Creek tours

For three years, he evaded every attempt to capture him, and led the police on a merry dance that made his legend grow. He was truly Jalgangurru
(man of magical powers).
